Immunomodulating therapeutics targeting the PD1/PD-L1 axis are increasingly prescribed in routine oncological practice. Expression of PD-L1 is considered the best predictive biomarker to date, bringing pathologists in the focus of this rapidly developing field.

- But have the studies to date really confirmed the value of PD-L1 expression?
- Which are the clones available and what are the differences?
- How are we supposed to score the stainings?
- And is that the same in every tumor entity?

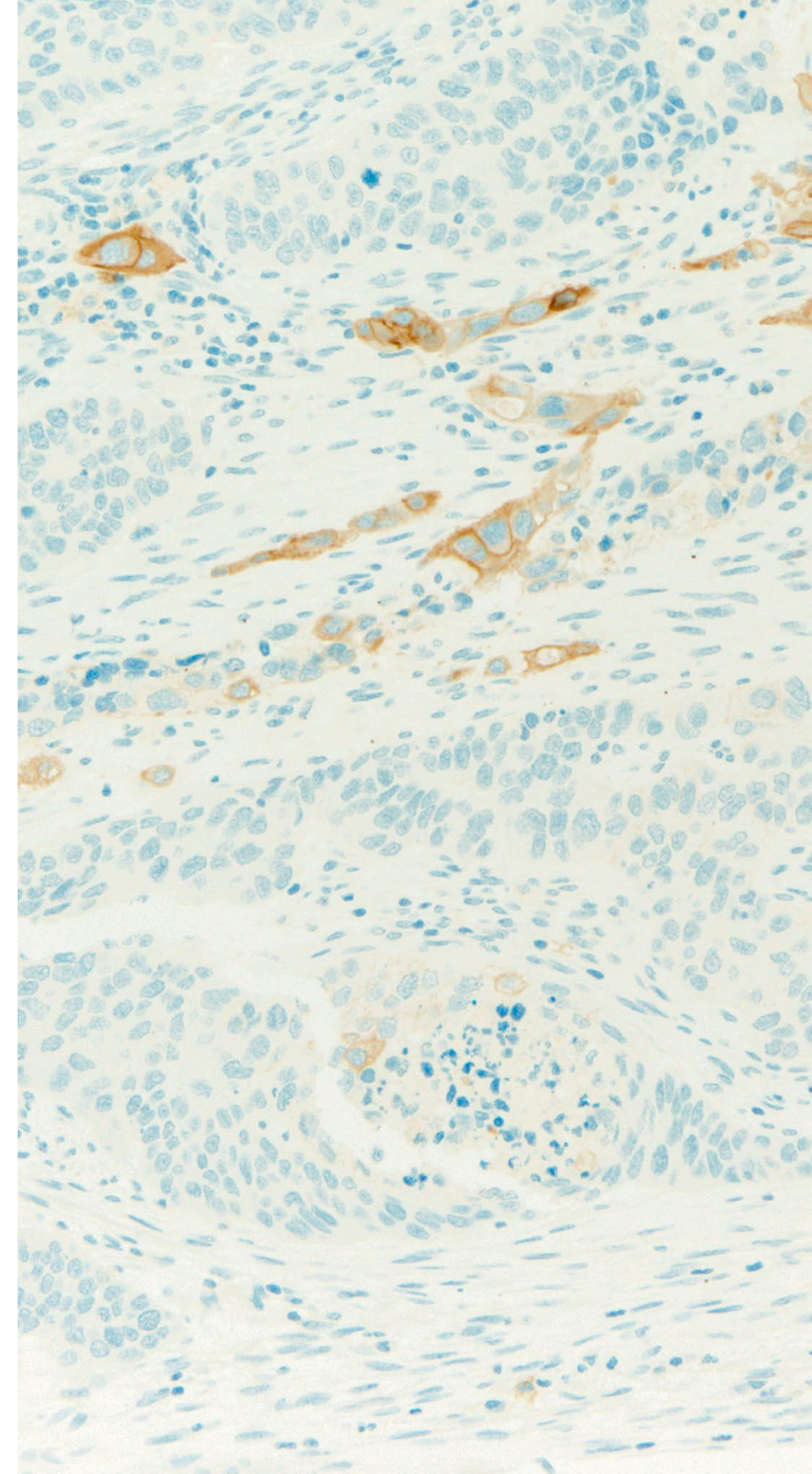

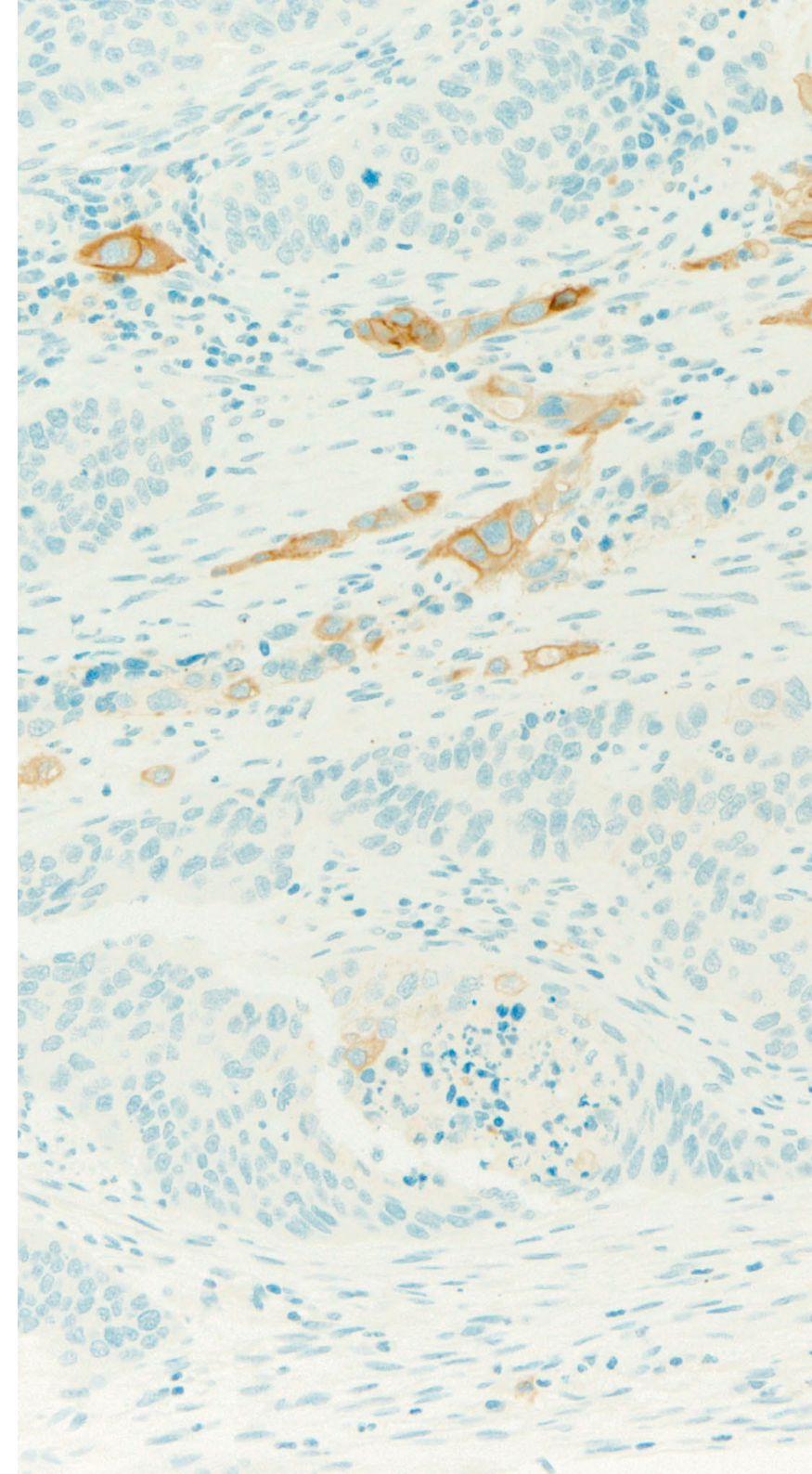
